THE FAFSA

If you've not done so already, complete your electronic FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov right away! **Our FAFSA code is 001243.**

YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARD

Once the initial information from the FAFSA has been received by our Office of Student Financing, you'll be mailed a preliminary financial aid package. Please note—you and your parents may be required to send additional documents to finalize your financial aid package. You must submit all of the required documents before July 1. Call your Admission Counselor if you have any questions.

On-Campus Living

On-campus living at Mount St. Mary's College is a very important part of the educational experience. Professional staff, Resident Assistants, and the students work together to provide an environment that supports intellectual, academic, personal and spiritual growth. Students at both the Doheny and Chalon campuses may live on-campus and benefit from the rich variety of opportunities and programs available at the Mount.

Chalon Residence Halls

BRADY

Brady houses 153 students on three floors and features sinks in most rooms and community bathrooms.

CASA

The Casa is used as male housing. Fourteen male residents live in the Casa, including one Resident Assistant.

CARONDELET

Carondelet houses 204 students in double and single rooms, arranged in suites with two rooms (2 to 4 students) sharing one bathroom.

ROSSITER

Rossiter houses 66 students in single rooms (each with a half bath) and community-style showers, or double rooms with two shared bathrooms. Six male students are housed in large double rooms on the first floor.

YATES AND ALDWORTH

Yates and Aldworth house 47 residents on three floors in small doubles, large doubles, and single half-baths.

Doheny Residence Halls

MCINTYRE

Houses 95 students in double rooms, arranged in suites with two rooms (4 students) sharing one bathroom.

HANNON

Houses 50 students in double rooms, arranged in suites with two rooms (4 students) sharing one bathroom.

Each room comes equipped with an extra-long twin bed, a desk and chair, a bulletin board, and a shared closet and dresser. Refrigerators, microwaves and laundry facilities are available in most residence halls.

Please note: If you have a documented physical disability or medical condition, and you need to request a specific room type, you must first contact Disability Support Services at 310.954.4144 (Chalon) or 213. 477.2690 (Doheny).
