WebAdvisor

WebAdvisor is the online tool Mount students use to check their financial aid awards, search for upcoming classes, register, see their class schedules, grades, and more. There will be many more additions to WebAdvisor in the upcoming months, so stay tuned to see what is coming next. A login and password are required to access WebAdvisor.

Student Labs

Each campus has a variety of computer labs for students to prepare papers, do research, check email, surf the net, etc. The computers are equipped with Microsoft Office, Internet Explorer and Netscape Communicator and the labs are equipped with laser printers.

Classroom Usage

Dedicated technology classrooms are networked for interactive teaching and have additional software supportive of the learning environment. Both campuses are wireless. MSMC bookstores sell the network card necessary to utilize this technology.

Computers in the Residence Halls

Every room has a network connection which will allow you to connect your PC or Macintosh computer to the College's internet and email services. More detailed information will be available to you at Orientation, but in the meantime you can visit the Office of Information Technology website at www.msmc.la.edu for detailed information on what you will need to connect your computer to our network while on campus.

Telephones

All residence hall rooms have voice telephone service installed and each resident is provided with an individual voicemail box. At Orientation, you will receive a packet of information with calling instructions, how to set up and use your voicemail, information on rules and regulations, etc.

Please note: Students will use the College's designated long distance service (not Sprint, AT&T, MCI, etc). Students may use personal calling cards as well as pre-paid calling cards.

Email

Each new student has been provided with an email account through Google Apps, which can be accessed from anywhere in the world through the internet. Google Apps provides web-based collaboration tools, including shared calendars and document storage with share and online edit capabilities. It is important to check your email frequently for updates on campus events, notifications from your faculty, and more. This address is your official email address.
