Mount St. Mary's College is pleased to announce the 2011 William Randolph Hearst Scholarship Program. Teaching Credential/Masters in Education Program Scholarships in the amount of \$5000 will be awarded to eligible candidates for the Summer 2011 incoming class of students intending to teach in public schools. Tuition credit will be awarded in two installments during the first year at the College., Fall 2011 and Spring 2012.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be U.S. citizens who: 1) intend to remain permanent residents of the U.S., 2) are committed to teaching in public schools, 3) demonstrate financial need, 4) are first time MSMC graduate students, 5) hold a minimum 3.0 GPA, 6) meet all admission requirements, 7) are accepted to a MSMC combined Credential/Masters Program (see Graduate Admission Office for Admission Requirements), 8) maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA, and 9) are continuously enrolled full time each term (6 units per term, usually 2 classes). Scholarship recipients must meet all other requirements of the College and graduate program as specified in the Catalog, Graduate Student Handbooks, and other College publications.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

- To apply for a 2011 William Randolph Hearst Foundation Education Scholarship, submit all required admissions and financial aid materials to the Graduate Admission Office and Financial Aid Office by March 30, 2011. Completion of a FAFSA form is required.
- Submit 1) a scholarship questionnaire (contact jverceles@msmc.la.edu to receive an electronic form), 2) two letters of recommendation (academic or professional letters addressing the applicant's potential in the field of public school education), and 3) a statement about your future career goals to the Chair of the Education Department, Mount St. Mary's College, 10 Chester Place, Los Angeles, CA 90007.

SELECTION PROCESS

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee of the faculty of the Education Department of Mount St. Mary's College. Awards will be based on financial need, exceptional letters of recommendation, academic promise, and potential contribution to teaching in public schools.

SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE

Priority deadline for submission of all materials is April 15, 2011.

VERIFICATION

I hereby verify that the information I have provided is true and correct. I understand that this scholarship is only available to a select number of qualified students who have been admitted to a Teaching Credential/Masters combined program.

I understand that this scholarship will be made as tuition credit only for the Fall 2011-Spring 2012 semesters as long as I remain continuously enrolled full time (6 units each term, Summer, Spring, and Fall) with a cumulative GPA minimum of 3.0.
